A CHAPLET OF REPARATION TO THE HOLY FACE OF JESUS

(Given by Our Lord to Sr. Mary of St. Peter to battle against the enemies of God, especially communists.)

On the Crucifix say: O God, come to my aid. O Lord, make haste to help me. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit... ETERNAL FATHER I offer Thee the cross of Our Lord Jesus Christ and all the other instruments of His Holy Passion, that Thou may put division in the camp of Thy enemies; for as Thy Beloved Son has said, "A kingdom divided against itself shall fall."

On the next five beads say:

- 1. May God arise and let His enemies be scattered and let those who hate Him flee before His Face!
- 2. May the thrice Holy Name of God overthrow all their plans!
- 3. May the Holy Name of the Living God split them up by disagreements!
- 4. May the terrible Name of the God of Eternity stamp out all their godlessness!
- 5. Lord, I do not desire the death of the sinner, but that he be converted and live. "Father, forgive them for they know not what they do."

On the medal say: the "GOLDEN ARROW" prayer. (Dictated by Our Lord to Sr. Mary of St. Peter.)

May the most holy, most sacred, most adorable, most incomprehensible and unutterable Name of God be always praised, blessed, loved, adored and glorified, in Heaven, on earth, and under the earth, by all the creatures of God, and by the Sacred Heart of Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar. Amen.

(After receiving this prayer, Sr. Mary of St. Peter was given a vision in which she saw the Sacred heart of Jesus delightfully wounded by this "Golden Arrow", as torrents of graces streamed from It for the conversion of sinners.)

On each of the 6 Large beads say: "My Jesus, mercy" and a "Glory be to the Father....

On the next 33 small beads say: "Arise, O Lord, and let Thy enemies be scattered, and let those that hate Thee flee before Thy Face." (One large bead is followed by six small beads except the last large bead which is followed by three small beads. Each of the first five groupings are for remembrance for each of the five senses: hearing, feeling, tasting, smelling, seeing and for the thirty years of Jesus private life. We render homage to His face which suffered in each of these five senses. The last group [one large bead and three small beads] are for the three years of Jesus public life. All together seven "Glory Be's" are said representing Christ's seven last words on the cross and the seven sorrows of Our Lady.)

On the medal at the end say: "Behold, O God our Protector, look upon us, and upon the face of Thy Christ." The following is recommended: "O Mary conceived without sin, Patroness of the United States of America, pray for us who have recourse to thee."

(You do not need a chaplet to say this prayer, you may use your fingers to keep track.)
